Flat Kart Rules

These rules take precedent over little sunset website/NKA/Maxxis Series rules regarding **all flat kart classes and supercedes all previous flyers.**

Open Clutch, no loop style headers. Pipes and silencers listed below Kart Number Must be on Both Sides and RF Nose for proper scoring

Open Tire rule for flat clone karts only no treaded tires 10 inch maximum rim width. Flat restrictors only no funnels

Engine Shroud Taping is acceptable for this event.

Flat Kart Transponders will be mounted at the base of the steering column

All Tires Must have 1mm of tread on middle 2 grooves before race- Remainder of Tire must Have Tread Pattern on Tire - Tech Officials decision will be final.

Predator Flat Karts - Hoosier JR2 320lbs 12-15

.500 Purple Plate

If it does not say you CAN do something to the Predator engine - YOU CAN NOT!!

Predator Flat Karts - Hoosier JR1 265lbs 8-12

.425 Green Plate

NO Prep - NO heated Tires, Must run same 4 tires from Hotlaps to end of A Feature.

If Same Set of tires ran in heat races do not have tread depth of 1mm before A - DQ

Special note on Tires - One set of tires used per night - Same Four used in same location for Hotlaps Heat Races and Features

Any Tire that requires being changed will result in Having to start at the rear of remaining races for that evening. Tires will be marked and Serial Numbers will be recorded. No Cleaning/Washing/Sanding of tires after they have been presented for Pre Tech - Must remain uncleaned for entire event - No Prep - No alteration to the tire. **Transponders Mount at the Base of the steering Column**

Drivers are responsible for recording the serial # of all four tires during pre-tech on Saturday and Sunday. #s must match after A or DQ will result

Right Rear & Right Front: RaceSaver Champ Kart 12.0/8.0-6 (11939RS) on 10" rims

Left Rear & Left Front: RaceSaver Champ Kart 11.0/5.5-6 (11901RS) on 6.0 or 6.5" rims

NKK/Adrenaline rules will be run - Drum/Disc Clutch Tail Tanks are not required, Side Pods/Side Plates are ok.

No Shock Absorbers or similar devices anywhere on the cage or the suspension. Hoosier D50 on RR

Hoosier Tires all 4 Corners, No Bald Tires, These are treaded tires and must be raced that way. Officials have final Say on Acceptable Tread

RR 45 Durometer Rule Before Race - No Heated Tires must be within 10 degrees of Baseline tire located in staging - Same as Flat Cart Rule above

Body Rules will be Relaxed in order to allow karts that do not race at NKK on a weekly basis to race, we reserve the right to require changes in order To Have a fair and competitive show. Pull Start or Electric Starter is acceptable - Shroud taping is OK

Age for winged cage kart classes will be determined using NKA Rule "Competition Age 10.3.5.1" Age Turned during 2025 is Age for Turkey Chase

If someone has raced in a Class all season long at their racetrack and show up on the points for that class they will be allowed to race it.

No minimum tread depth - tread pattern must be visible - If you aren't sure ask! No heated tires - same rule as flat karts above.

Any Aggressive grinding will result in disqualification.

Car/Hoo - Means use of either Carlisle Tire or Hoosier in LSS Rules, no weight break.

digital tachs/lap timers only allowed Adult Clone/SR 206/Wazoom cage kart classes **only** - must be removed from all other karts not just unplugged.

engine shroud taping will be allowed on cage karts. **All Transponders Must be mounted on Rear Cross Bar behind Driver**

Competitors will be allowed to race in classes they have raced all season, Age will be a taken into consideration as will experience

Age for all LSS Cage Cart Classes will be determined using LSS Rule - Age on December 26th 2024 is age for 2025 Turkey Chase

Cage Predator Class Rules - Must Use Blue River Raceway Sealed Package, Available for Rent or Purchase (engine only)

Removal of stock tank is okay, use of a top plate and external fuel pump is acceptable. Fuel Tank must be securely mounted to the floor pan.

Clone Engines for any cage class outside of the rookie cage class must be sealed in a manner that is acceptable to Mini E, Blue River or Kam Rules.

Bearing Clutch OK for all non-wing cage kart classes
